21th Annual NW Ice Fishing Derby FISHING CONTEST RULES

Contest Fishing time 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. ALL fishing contest participants <u>must check in</u> to complete registration and get a number assigned, at the Molson Grange Hall in advance, and be licensed to fish.

Grand Prize of a \$500 check and a \$500 gift certificate from Country Store will be awarded to the adult contestant with longest single fish. Youth Grand Prize is \$300 for the youth with the longest fish. Optional Adult weight category, with heaviest total weight of up to 5 fish, will receive \$300 minimum. This payout is driven by the total entry fees in the pot, so could be more than \$300.

Contestants can only win one of the Grand Prizes should they have an entry in both "longest fish" and "total weight category".

For questions or communication with Derby Officials at the lake visit:

The opinion of the panel of judges is final for contest placements. If you are declared a winner, all of your fish must be present with you at the Molson Grange Hall. All winning contestant's fish in the weight category will be opened/inspected. In the event of ties, the weight of the biggest fish will be used as a tie-breaker. Your registration must be readable and complete. It is your responsibility to follow WA Department of Fish and Wildlife rules to fish.

You and persons with you are participating in the NW Ice Fishing Derby at YOUR OWN RISK and must sign our liability waiver. Use your own judgment concerning safety at all times.

The Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife rules **MUST** be followed for fishing. <u>Five (5)</u> Fish limit. No catch and release. All fish need to be weighed at the Weigh Station <u>immediately</u>. You must be in line to weigh your last fish prior to and no later than 1:00 pm. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Awards & Raffle results will follow in the Grange Hall.

<u>All holes must be augured no larger diameter than 10 inches.</u> There will be no axes, chain saws or other tools or equipment allowed to put a hole in the ice. Use an abandoned hole if possible.

- No fishing in open water or within 100 feet of open water
- Parents are to be responsible for their children and pets.

PROTECT OUR HIGHLAND FREEDOMS, PLEASE:

- If you have a pet, please <u>clean up after them</u>. Pets must not bother other visitors.
- Do not leave garbage. <u>Please haul out your own trash</u>. You may bring ice huts, chairs and iceboxes, etc. There will be food and beverages at the Grange Hall.
- <u>PLEASE KEEP PARKING SPOTS OPEN for Emergency Services, which will be on site.</u>
- Parking is free. Please do not park in derby staff spots.

- All assigned prizes must be picked up by contestant or representative on that day.
- Raffle winners must be present to win, however you may have a friend hold your ticket for you and take possession of any prizes you are awarded.
